International meeting in support of Israeli-Palestinian peace
12-13 February 2010, Malta

The **Parliamentary Assembly of the Mediterranean (PAM)** and the **United Nations**, through the **Committee on the Exercise of the Inalienable Rights of the Palestinian people**, are jointly organising the **International meeting in support of Israeli-Palestinian peace**. The event will take place **on 12-13 February 2010, in Qawra, Malta**.

The meeting will focus on the **five key elements** being addressed by the Israeli-Palestinian Peace Process namely **borders, settlements, refugees, water and Jerusalem**. Renowned experts and key actors from the region and the international community will participate together with Israeli and Palestinian members of Parliament.

The objective of the meeting is to provide representatives of the national parliaments of the Mediterranean region belonging to PAM, as well as parliamentary delegates from across Europe, the United States, Russia and the Gulf countries, the opportunity to become fully familiar with and brought up to date on the current efforts, led by key actors, towards a lasting peace in the region, as well as with the latest thinking and state of play in respect of the 5 highlighted issues.

Both organisations are strongly committed to further their efforts in raising awareness among MPs and the parliaments of the region with the hope to contribute to reaching a common understanding on the issues at stake and agree on a possible way forward. The meeting will provide participating MPs with additional information they may require to engage in parliamentary diplomacy at the national, regional and international level.
